#### **From the East / Montreal**

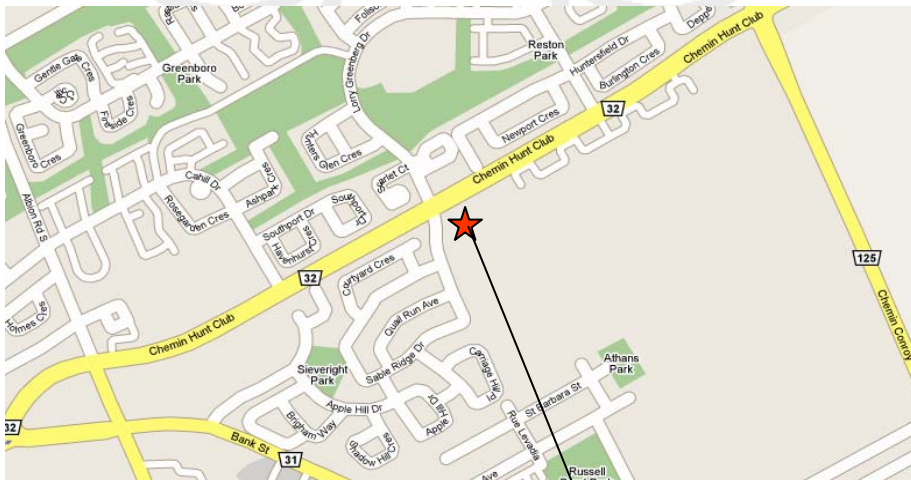
- 1) From Highway 417 West, take the Walkley Rd Exit #112, go west
